SEC. 5. *Be it enacted*, That the right is hereby express- Rights reser-

ly reserved to the legislature at its pleasure, to amend or
annul this act of incorporation.

SEC. 6. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall inure for thir- In force
ty years, unless sooner repealed by the General Assembly.

CHAPTER 165.

*An act for the relief of Penelope D. Goodwin, of Balti- Passed March
more County. 1, 1842.*

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, To set aside
inquisition
fund, etc.
That Baltimore county court is hereby authorized and requir-
ed to set aside the inquisition fund, for the Baltimore and Sus-
quehannah Rail Road Company, condemning the lands of
Penelope D. Goodwin of said county, and that said court
direct an inquisition de novo to be taken, and that such pro-
ceedings be had as in cases where inquisitions in similar
cases are set aside by the court.

CHAPTER 166.

*An act to divorce Sarah A. Dove, of Prince George's Passed March
County, from her husband William Dove. 1, 1842.*

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Divorced
Maryland*, That Sarah A. Dove, be and she is hereby div-
orced from her husband William Dove, a vinculo matri-
monii.
