An act giving power to the Commissioners for Talbot Coun- Passed March ty, to appoint annually a Collector of Direct Taxes in said County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma-commission-ers to appoint ryland, That the commissioners for Talbot county, be and collector they are hereby empowered, should they deem it necessary, to appoint in the month of August, and annually thereafter, a collector, whose duty it shall be to collect such taxes as may be levied under the act of March session, eighteen hundred and forty-one, chapter twenty-three, and its several supplements; provided, that nothing herein contained shall Proviso. apply to the county collector, in the discharge of duties now required of him by existing enactments, except so far as the repeal of any part of the law of March session, eighteen hundred and forty-one, chapter twenty-three, may be necessary to carry this act into effect.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That any law or parts of any Repealed law conflicting with the first section of this act, be and the
