An act to alter and amend the Constitution and Form of Passed March Government of the State of Maryland, so as to substi- 4, 1842 tute biennial for annual sessions of the Legislature, and for other purposes.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Elect Maryland, That the first election held in pursuance of this years act, shall take place on the first Wednesday of October, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty-four, and on that day forever thereafter elections shall be held once in two years.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the delegates elected Delegates to on the first Wednesday of October, eighteen hundred and be chosen for forty-four, and at all succeeding elections forever thereaf- two years ter, shall be chosen for two years.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the General Assembly Last Monday shall meet on the last Monday in December, eighteen hun- in December dred and forty-four, and on the same day in every second year forever thereafter, and at no other time unless conven-

ed by proclamation of the governor. SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the term of office of Elected for the governor elected on the first Wednesday of October, four years eighteen hundred and forty-four, shall commence on the first Monday of January next ensuing the day of such election and continue for four years and until the election and qualification of a successor.
