CHAPTER 243.

A supplement to an act entitled, an act to provide more ef- Passed Feb fectually, for the distruction of Wolves, Panthers, and 19, 1842. Foxes, in Allegany County, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty, chapter fifty-six.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of One dollar allowed. Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, every person who shall kill or destroy any wild cat, within the limits of Allegany county, shall be entitled to an allowance from said county, of one dollar and fifty cents for every wild cat so killed or destroyed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That upon the production of Commissiona certificate of a justice of the peace, as is required by the second section of the act to which this act is a supplement, the commissioners of Allegany county, be and they are hereby authorised and required, to levy upon the assessable property of said county the above mentined allowance of one dollar and fifty cents, for every wild cat so killed and destroyed, for the use of the person producing the same.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That in order to obtain such Comply with an allowance, the person killing or destroying any wild cat, on. shall in every respect comply with the second section of the act to which this act is a supplement.
