

ceeding three thousand dollars, and personal estate not exceeding three thousand dollars, which estate shall never be divided among the members of the corporation, but shall descend to their successors, subject to the payment of the just debts to be incurred by said corporation. CHAP. 243.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That Thomas Rizer, shall have the power to call the first meeting of said corporation by appointing a time and place therefor, and giving written notice thereof to the other persons named and incorporated by this act, at least three days before such time of meeting. Thomas Rezin to call a meeting.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this corporation shall not be permitted to issue negotiable note or notes, in the form of bank notes. Issue forbid

SEC. 6. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall at any time be subject to repeal or modification by the legislature of this State. Rights reserved.

CHAPTER 243.

*A supplement to an act entitled, an act to provide more effectually, for the distruction of Wolves, Panthers, and Foxes, in Allegany County, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty, chapter fifty-six.* Passed Feb 19, 1842.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, every person who shall kill or destroy any wild cat, within the limits of Allegany county, shall be entitled to an allowance from said county, of one dollar and fifty cents for every wild cat so killed or destroyed. One dollar allowed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That upon the production of a certificate of a justice of the peace, as is required by the second section of the act to which this act is a supplement, the commissioners of Ailegany county, be and they are hereby authorised and required, to levy upon the assessable property of said county the above mentined allowance of one dollar and fifty cents, for every wild cat so killed and destroyed, for the use of the person producing the same. Commissioners to levy.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That in order to obtain such an allowance, the person killing or destroying any wild cat, shall in every respect comply with the second section of the act to which this act is a supplement. Comply with second section.
