An act to authorize the division of the Real Estate of Wil-Passed March liam and Mary Elbert.

WHEREAS, a certain William Elbert and Mary his wife, Preamble. of Queen Anne's county, died many years ago, and before the passage of the act of seventeen hundred and eighty-six, chapter forty-five, being the act to direct descents and the said William and Mary Elbert were seized at the time of their death of lands in said county, which descended upon four daughters, and by reason that the descent of said lands was cast prior to the passage of the said act, the descendants of the said William and Mary have not been able to make a division conformable to the provisions of the said act, and a petition for the division of said lands was heretofore dismissed in Queen Anne's county court, and it hath been represented to this General Assembly, that some of the parties interested in the said lands are desirous to have a division thereof, but have not been able to effect that object by agreement, owing to the infancy and coverture of some of the said parties.

SECTION 1.
