

CHAP. 336. of two thirds tolls in favor of all wheel carriages, whose tract shall be of the one pair of wheels clearly outside of the usual track of five feet, and of the other pair of wheels, out side of it; *provided*, that wheel carriages of the last description whose width of tire shall enable them to roll eight inches on each side shall pass toll free.

Repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 336.

Passed March 10, 1842. *A supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate proceedings against Corporations, passed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, chapter three hundred and six.*

Writ to be served on the clerk, etc *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That in all cases in which suits are instituted in any of the courts of law or equity of this State; against an incorporated company, the office of which is located in this State, it shall be the duty of the plaintiffs to cause a summons or writ or a copy thereof, to be served on the clerk of the company, or in case of his absence, to cause the same to be left at the office of such company at least fifteen days before the return day of the same, and to file in said case, the affidavit of some disinterested person, that the same had been duly served or left at the said office, and no court of law or equity in this State, shall hear or entertain any suit against such incorporated company, unless they shall be satisfied that the provisions of this act have been complied with; *provided*, that this act shall not apply to suits which may be instituted in the county where the office of the company is held.
