BALTIMORE CO.—Authorized to appoint as many collectors of taxes as they may deem expedient, collections to be made by collection districts &c., not more than one collector to each district, &c., rate of commission not to exceed 7 per cent on the whole collection in, &c.

Collectors to pay over to the county treasurer every month the amounts collected, collections to be completed within 12 months after receiving the list of property, on failure to pay over &c., to forfeit amount of commission for the month, &c., on failure to complete the whole, suit to be brought on bonds, &c.

On neglect, &c., of any person to pay tax, collector to enforce payment by distress, &c.

Collectors to report to the commissioners &c., all property chargeable with taxes, &c. and whereon the taxes not been paid &c.

Commissioners to sell such property &c., if any wood sufficient to pay taxes, to sell said wood, &c., if land be sold treasurer of Baltimore county to execute a deed, &c.

Former acts inconsistent, repealed,

The tax of two per cent provided for by the 2d sec. of the act of 1835, ch. 235, and the 1st sec. of the act of 1836, ch. 133, except as to cases of insolvents now pending and unsettled, and in lieu of said per centage there shall be imposed on all monies to be deposited in Baltimore county court, or coming into hands of trustees or other officers of said court or persons for distribution, &c., the sum of one per cent to be paid to the clerk, to be accounted for and paid over as directed by said 2nd section, &c.,
