FREDDRICK COUNTY BANK.—Capital stock to be reduced to \$150,000. 45 1

Reduced capital may be augmented, etc. " 2

In case any of the money, etc. included in the extent of losses by which capital of said bank has been reduced shall be recovered, the President, etc. to have power either to add the same to the capital and shares of the stockholders, or to cause dividends to be made, etc. " 3

Tax of 20 cents on each \$100 paid in, now required to be paid into the treasury, to be paid only on the stock reduced, etc. " 4

FREE NEGROES AND MULATTOES.—If any free negro, etc. shall knowingly call for, etc. any abolition handbill, etc. having a tendency to create insurrection, etc. among the people of color, etc. to be deemed guilty of felony, and upon conviction, to be sentenced to the penitentiary for not less than ten years, nor more than twenty, etc. 272 1

The duty of every inhabitant knowing that such handbill is or shall have been in the possession of any free negro, to give
