And be it further enacted, by the authority afore- To enter plea said, That after the withdrawal of the plea of not guilty convict aforesaid, it shall and may be lawful for the said James Chaney alias James W. Chaney, and he is hereby authorised to enter the said case of the State of Maryland against him, the plea of autrefois convict; provided, that the said Proviso plea of autrefois convict shall have no other or further effect than it would have had if interposed in said case, before the plea of not guilty was therein entered.
