CHAPTER 73.

An act for the benefit of Anna Maria Beyers, a lunatic, of Passed Feb Carroll County.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Levy author-That the commissioners of tax of Carroll county, be and ized for her they are hereby authorized in their discretion, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, a sum of money not exceeding fifty dollars, for the use of Anna Maria Beyers, a lunatic, to be paid to such trustee as the said commissioners may appoint.

CHAPTER 74.

An act relating to the Levy Court of Queen Ann's County. Passed Feb

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Repealed Maryland, That so much of the seventh section of the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twentyeight, chapter fourteen, as requires the levy court of Queen Ann's county, to set every day during the spring term of the county court, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the justices of the levy May meet as court aforesaid, may and they are hereby authorized to often as nemeet as often as in their judgment, occasion may require, between the first day of April, and last day of May, in each and every year, for the purposes mentioned in the said sec-
