CHAPTER 76.

An act for the protection of Mechanics and others, in Alle- Passed Jan 27 gany County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Lien on all Maryland, That every building erected within the limits of buildings any city or town in Allegany county, shall be subject to a lien for the payment of all debts contracted for work done or materials furnished on or about the erection or construction of the same.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the lien of such debts, Lien to apply shall extend to the ground covered by such buildings, and to grounds atto so much other ground immediately adjacent thereto and buildings belonging in like manner to the owner of such building, as may be necessary for the ordinary and useful purposes of such buildings.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That every person entitled to Clerk to keep such lien shall file a claim or statement of his demand in docket, and the office of the clerk of said county court, whose duty it for liens shall be to keep a book or docket which shall be called the mechanics lien docket," in which he shall cause to be entered and recorded all claims that may be filed by virtue of this act, noting on said claims the day on which the same were filed.
