The proper date in Specific spirit An act to authorize the employment of additional Collectors Passed Feb in Saint Mary's and Worcester Counties. 7, 1842.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma-Collector to be appointed ryland, That the commissioners of the tax for Saint Mary's for each disand Worcester counties, are hereby authorized to appoint trict a collector of the county taxes for each district in Saint Mary's and Worcester counties; provided, they shall be of opinion that such change in the mode of collecting the county taxes, would conduce to greater public interest and convenience; and provided also, that the entire expense of collection shall not exceed the sum now levied for such object.
