SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be law- General powful for the managers of schools in any or either of the election districts in said county, at their pleasure to lay off said election district into suitable school districts, and file a certificate (numbering and designating the same) in the office of the commissioners of said county, then, and in that case, it shall be lawful for the managers of schools in said district, to use the money arising from the school fund, to which their district is entitled, to aid in the payment of teachers, or building school houses in said school districts; provided, the Provisoes. same be divided proportionably to the number of children in each school district, between the ages of seven and eighteen years; which said dividend shall be for the use of the school district, to which it is assigned and for no other use whatever; and provided further, that their orders drawn for the same, or any part thereof, shall be signed by all the
