CHAPTER 104.

Passed Feb 7, 1842. *An act relating to the Reports of the School Commissioners of Caroline County, and for other purposes.*

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That so much of the sixteenth section of an act passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter two hundred and twelve, as requires the register of wills of Caroline county, to record the reports and returns of the commissioners of the free and charity school fund of said county, to the orphans court, and all the reports and certificates of the trustees of the located schools in said county, and so much of the seventh section of the aforesaid act as requires that the justices of the orphans court shall annex all the reports of the district commissioners and trustees of the located schools to their returns to the General Assembly, be and the same are hereby repealed, but it shall be the duty of the said register to preserve and file the same in his office, among the papers relating to the school fund of said county.

To preserve papers Report to be made in June instead of December

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the several boards of district commissioners, to return as directed by the seventh section of the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-four, chapter two hundred and twelve, a full report of their proceedings at the December session of the orphans court, instead of at the June session, as heretofore directed.
