CHAPTER 111.

Passed Feb 18, 1842. *An act to divorce Christianna Limberger, of Washington County, from her husband Joseph Limberger, and to change her name.*

Divorced *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Christianna Limberger, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Joseph Limberger, a vinculo matrimonii, and the said Christianna is hereby authorized and empowered to resume, take and use her maiden name of Christianna Seabar.*

CHAPTER 112.

Passed Feb 18, 1842. *An act to divorce Mary Nugent, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Arthur Nugent.*

Divorced *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Mary Nugent, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Arthur Nugent, a vinculo matrimonii.*

CHAPTER 113.

Passed Feb 18, 1842. *An act to divorce Thomas Sollers, of Anne Arundel County, from his wife Catharine Sollers.*

Divorced *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Thomas Sollars, be and he is hereby divorced from his wife Catharine Sollars, a vinculo matrimonii.*

Passed Feb 18, 1842. *An act to divorce Sarah A. Shallus, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Samuel W. Shallus.*

Divorced *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sarah A. Shallus, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Samuel W. Shallus, a vinculo matrimonii.*
