Clarke, William Gephart and others, who are, or may hereafter become members thereof, be and they are hereby deciared to be one company corporation and body politic forever hereafter, by the name and style of the Canada Fire Company; the object of which company is hereby declared to be the protection of the property of the citizens of Cumberland from destruction by fire, for which purpose they are hereby made able and capable in law to have, purchase, receive, possess and retain, to them and their successors, lands, tenements, rents, annuities and other hereditaments, and the same to grant, devise, alien and dispose of as they may judge most conducive to the interest of said company, provided nevertheless, that the said corporation or body po- proviso. litic shall not at any time hold or possess property real and personal or mixed, exceeding the sum of five thousand dol-

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said company and their successors, by the aforesaid name, shall forever here-powers. after be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, defend and be defended in all and every court of justice whatever, and also to have, make and use a common seal, and the same to break, alter and renew at pleasure, and to assemble and meet together at such times and places as they may agree upon, and to ordain, establish and put in execution, such bye-laws and ordinances and regulations as to them shall seem to be conducive to the interest of the said company, and necessary to the good government and orderly management thereof, and generally to do and execute all such acts, matters and things as to them shall or may appertain to do. the same not being contrary to the laws of this state.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That nothing herein contained, shall be so construed as to authorize or empower notes forbid. said corporation to issue any note, token, certificate or other evidence of debt to be used as a currency, and that nothing herein contained shall be construed to deny to the legislature the right to repeal this law at pleasure.
