bank stock, registered debts or other public securities with- CHAP. 154. in this State, and the same at their pleasure to alter, transfer, sell or lease, in such manner as they may deem most conducive to the interest of the said corporations; provided, Proviso, that the said corporation shall not at any one time hold or possess property real, personal or mixed, exceeding in total value the sum of one thousand dollars.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be Common seal. lawful for the said corporation and their successors to have a common seal for their use, and the same to alter, break or make anew at their pleasure, and shall in general have and exercise all such rights, privileges, purchases and immunities as are by law incident and necessary to corporations of this kind.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act shall Issues forbid. be so construed to authorize the said corporation to issue any note, token, device, scrip or other evidence of debt to be used as currency.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this act of incorpora- Enure for 30 tion shall enure for thirty years, and the legislature hereby years. reserves to itself the right to change, alter or annul this act of incorporation at pleasure.

CHAPTER 153.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Commission-That the commissioners of Baltimore county be, and they ers to place are hereby authorized, to place the commissions of all in hands of supervisors of roads in said county into the hands of the collectors. different collectors of taxes for distribution, whose duty it shall be to distribute the same according to the directions of said commissioners.
