## CHAPTER 175.

An act to lay out, open and make public a road in Wor- Passed March cester County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Commission-Maryland, That Rolin Bevans, William B. Corbin, and ers. Levin J. M. P. Broadwater, of Worcester county, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and open a new road not exceeding thirty feet in width, beginning at the first fork of the road leading from Broadwater's landing, and running direct from said fork on the straightest and hest ground to intersect the county road, leading from Nassawango bridge, to dividing creek bridge, at or near the north east corner of a tract of land called Handy's choice, and that the said commissioners shall make out a plat of the road, and return the same to the clerk of Worcester county court to be recorded amongst the records of said county, and the said road when so opened shall be deemed to be a public road forever, and shall be kept in repair in the same manner, as all other public roads are directed to be kept up in said county.
