CHAPTER 185.

Passed March 4, 1843. *A supplement to an act entitled, An act to abolish Magistrate's Courts in Dorchester County, and to extend the jurisdiction of a single Justice of the Peace in said county, passed December session eighteen hundred and forty-one, chapter one hundred and twenty-seven.*

Acts made valid.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That by the true construction of the third section of said act, a single justice of the peace has power to issue execution on all judgments authorized to be rendered by a single justice under said section, and all executions heretofore issued in virtue of said section, and all proceedings in lawful execution thereof, are hereby confirmed and made valid.

Clerk may issue execution.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the clerk of the county court to issue execution on the application of the proper party on any judgment, on the dockets returned to his office, under the fourth section of said act, returnable to the said court in the usual form.

CHAPTER 186.

Passed March 4, 1843. *An act to continue in force such acts of Assembly as would expire during the present session.*

Expiring laws re-enacted.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all such acts or parts of acts as would expire with the present session of the general assembly, be and the same are hereby re-enacted and continued in force to the last Monday of December next, and to the end of the session of the general assembly next thereafter; *provided however,* that this act shall not extend to or embrace any acts or parts of acts which may have been or shall be repealed or in any wise modified at the present session of the general assembly; *and provided further,* that nothing herein contained shall be construed to extend to renewal of charters of banks or
