CHAPTER 187.

An act entitled, An act relating to Primary Schools of Passed Feb. Prince George's County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Teachers to Maryland, That from and after the first day of June next, receive fixed the teachers employed to take charge of the Primary Schools in Prince George's county, shall be paid a certain fixed sum at the discretion of the board of trustees appointed by the Levy Court, to be rated either quarterly or monthly, for each and every scholar admitted into said school; provided, that no teacher shall receive for any one Proviso, year more than three hundred and fifty dollars nor less than one hundred and fifty for his services.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the trustees appointed Trustees to by the levy court under the provisions of the act of eigh-regulate and teen hundred and thirty eight, to which this is a further supprescribe plement, shall prescribe some mode to ensure the more re-tendance of gular attendance of the scholars, and more strict accountascholars. bility of teachers, and for this purpose they are authorized to make such bye-laws and regulations for the more correct

to make such bye-laws and regulations for the more correct government of the Primary Schools as they may in their judgment think proper, and all such bye-laws and regulations shall be binding on teachers, scholars and local trustees, and the local trustees may expel any scholar for any time not exceeding three months at one time, for bad conduct, and also to exclude all children under seven years of age whenever they shall think it best to do so, and they may also suspend for a limited time any scholar for irregular attendance, until they receive assurance from the parent, guardian or other person having charge of such scholar, that the attendance will be more regular.
