WHEREAS the dimentions and capacity of the barrels re- Preamble. quired by the third section of the act of December session eighteen hundred and forty-one, section third, are wholly unsuited to storage in cargo, and are moreover unusual and

difficult to make-therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Barrels not to Maryland, That all barrels which shall be made and used contain more for the purpose of packing or containing salted Fish, shall than 28 galbe seventeen inches between the chines, and twenty inches across the bilge, the staves to be twenty-eight inches in length, and that such barrels shall not be required to contain more than twenty-eight gallons.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts Repealed.
