CHAPTER 198.

Passed March A supplement to an act entitled, An act to give to the Chan-6, 1843. cellor and the County Courts, as Courts of Equity, jurisdiction in cases of divorce.

Divorce, &c.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That when an application is made to any court in this State having jurisdiction over the subject for a divorce a vinculo matrimonii, the fact that the parties have been divorced, a mensa et thoro shall not be taken to interfere with the jurisdiction of the court over the subject, and that any bill dismissed for such reason shall be reinstated and be acted upon de novo.

Admission of Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the admission of a rerespondent of spondent of the facts charged in a bill for a divorce, who facts charged consents to the application, shall not be taken of itself as conclusive proof of the facts charged, as the ground of the

application.

CHAPTER 199.

Passed March An act for the promotion of Education in Somerset county. 6, 1843.

Treasurer to pay over to order of commissioners.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western Shore be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay over to the order of the commissioners for Somerset county, all sums of money which are now or may hereafter be apportioned to said county, out of the common or free-school fund of said State, or which may be apportioned to said county out of the interest of the State's proportion of surplus fund of the United States, or which said county may be entitled to receive from the said State for common school purposes from any fund whatsoever.

School districts to resaid county shall be and remain as they are now laid off in main as they pursuance of the first section of an act of assembly passed now are.
