CHAPTER 210.

Passed March 1, 1843. *An act for the completion of the New Court House in Allegany County, and for other purposes.*

Commissioners to levy for building court house.

Proviso.

County commissioners to adjust amount school fund for public purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the commissioners of Allegany county be, and they are hereby authorised at any of their future annual meetings when the assessments are laid for defraying the county expenses, to allow for the use of the commissioners for building the new court house in said Allegany county, and to cause to be levied such sum or sums of money as may be necessary to pay for work, labor, and materials done and contracted for, before the passage of this act, and to provide doors, for the safe keeping of the public records, and to erect such out houses and lay such pavements, as the commissioners of said county may deem necessary; *provided,* the sums so levied shall not exceed, in the aggregate, the sum of five hundred dollars, over and above what may be necessary to pay for work done before the passage of this act, as they in their discretion may think proper to allow for the payment of work done, and to be done towards the completion of said court house, and for the improvement of the grounds adjoining thereto.

SEC. 2. *And be it also enacted,* That the said county commissioners may at any of their future meetings, adjust the amount with which the school fund of said county is to be credited for monies appropriated out of that fund for the use of the said court house commissioners and for other public purposes, and that the said county commissioners may if they think proper cause to be levied from year to year for the use of the treasurer of said school fund a sum sufficient to pay the annual interest upon the amount appropriated out of said fund as aforesaid, and that the said county commissioners may if they think proper at their future annual meetings as aforesaid, repay in such levies as they choose to the treasurer of said fund the principal sum appropriated as aforesaid.
