An act to regulate the meeting of the Orphan's Court of Mont- Passed Jan gomery County.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Time of meet-Maryland, That the regular terms of the Orphan's Court ing. of Montgomery County, shall be held on the second Tuesday in every month of February, April, June, August, October, and December, and the said Court shall by its adjournment, if necessary for the despatch of business, be held on the Tuesday of every week in the year other than the weeks of the regular terms.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Orphan's Session not to Court shall sit for the transaction of business, from nine exceed o'clock A. M. until four o'clock P. M. and the sessions of said Court shall not at any time exceed one day, except at the regular time of holding the County Courts of said County, when the said Orphan's Court may sit during the whole term of said County Court, if necessary for the despatch of business; provided nevertheless, that the said Or- Proviso, phan's Court shall be and is hereby authorised to continue its sessions from day to day, whenever it shall appear to them to be necessary, for the purpose of examining witnesses or hearing an argument or arguments in any case which they may hereafter have before them, where the examination of the witnesses, and the hearing of the argument cannot be concluded on the usual day of their meeting, upon which said examination of witnesses, or said argument shall have commenced.
