No 36.

Resolution relating to the Treasurer elect.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Passed March 10, 1843.
the Treasurer elect, before proceeding to act in the office to which he has been elected, shall give bond in the sum of two hundred thousand dollars, in the manner and form prescribed by the act of November session eighteen hundred and one, chapter sixty-six.

Resolution in favor of Samuel Kirby.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Passed March 10, 1843.
the Treasurer pay to Samuel Kirby, Sergeant at Arms of this house, fifty dollars, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury.

No. 38.

Resolution in favor of certain members of the Legislature.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Passed March 10, 1843.
the Treasurer of the western shore pay to such members of the Legislature as may be detained at the seat of government by sickness, four dollars per day during such detention.

No. 39.

Resolution in favor of John H. T. Magruder.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Passed March 10, 1843.
the Treasurer of the western shore pay out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to John H. T. Magruder, the sum of one hundred dollars, as compensation for labor done and services rendered under resolution um-
