COURT HOUSE IN ALLEGANY COUNTY—See *Allegany County.*

COURT OF APPEALS—On any appeal from any judgment in Orphan's Court, Register to make out and transmit to the Court of Appeals a full transcript or record of the proceedings, &c. within sixty days after the appeal, &c. 27 1

No appeal to be dismissed if the record is filed within sixty days from the entry of the appeal, or before the sitting of the next court after appeal is entered. " 2

Provisions of this law to take effect from date and apply to all cases now depending, &c. " 3

Case to be docketed for June term 1843, to be heard and determined, &c. 2

The Court not authorized to receive reverse or correct the order appealed from in favor of any of the parties to the writ, excepting the appellants, &c. and if on hearing said appeal said orders be reversed and it be determined that the appellees were not entitled, &c. then appellees to retain out of the monies which they may be required to pay to appellants such proportions as they paid to annuitants, &c. 3

Authorized to hear and determine an appeal in a case now pending in said Court in the name of John Kelly and others appellants, and Solomon Betts appellee, &c. 223

To entertain an appeal from the order of the Chancellor, passed 6th January 1829, if the same be taken by Wm. G. Penn within thirty days from the passage of this law, &c. 280 1

To hear said appeal next term after the record sent up, &c. " 2

Appeal bond to be given, if not, appeal not to operate as supersedeas. " 3

Authorized to re-instate the case of Mary Brown against Charles F. Mayer, &c. 284

In all cases pending in, &c. or depending in, court to entertain appeal although transcript shall not have been transmitted within
