

- CHAP. 45. respectively continue and be in full force until the time specified in their constitution for the next election of officers, or until they shall be removed from office in accordance with the provisions of the constitution
- Issues forbid. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That nothing in this act be so construed as to authorise the said corporation to issue any note, token, device, scrip or other evidence of debt, to be used as currency.
- Rights reserved. SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That this act of incorporation shall enure for thirty years from its passage, and the legislature reserves the right to alter or annul this act of incorporation at pleasure.

CHAPTER 44.

Passed Jan 25 1843. *An act to provide for the extension of the charter of the Fredericktown Savings Institution.*

- Charter extended. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the charter of the Fredericktown Savings Institution, be, and the same is hereby extended, to the year eighteen hundred and sixty, and to the end of the next session of General Assembly thereafter; *provided,* that nothing in the said charter shall be so construed as to authorise the aforesaid institution to issue any note, token, device, or other evidence of debt, to be used as a currency.
- Proviso. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the right is hereby reserved to the Legislature to change, alter, or annul, the said charter at pleasure.
- Rights reserved.

CHAPTER 45.

Passed Jan 30 1843. *An act to repeal an act entitled, an act to preserve the breed of Fish, in the waters of the Chesapeake Bay, and for other purposes.*

- Repealed. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the act entitled, an act to preserve the breed of fish in the waters of Chesapeake bay, and other purposes, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-one, chapter, two hundred and eighty-six, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
