CHAP. 87. lars, which estate shall never be divided among the members of the corporation, but shall descend to their successors, for the benevolent relief of the sick and distressed, the education of the orphans of its members, and for the promotion of their purposes general y.

Issues forbid.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this corporation shall not be permitted to issue any note, token, device, or scrip, or other evidence of debt, to be used as a currency.

Corportion to laws. Proviso.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this corporation shall amend bye-have power to alter and amend their bye-laws at pleasure; provided they do not conflict with the laws of the State of Maryland, the laws of the United States, or the laws of the Grand Lodge.

To enure for 30 years.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act of incorporation shall enure for thirty years from its passage, and that the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter, and annul this act of incorporation, at pleasure.

## CHAPTER 86.

Passed Feb. An act to confer additional powers upon the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore. 14, 1843.

Mayor and invested with power, &c.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. City Council That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, shall be, and they are hereby invested with full power to receive in trust, and to control for the purpose of such trusts, all money or other property of whatsoever description which may heretofore have been, or shall hereafter be bestowed upon such corporation by will, deed or in any other form of gift or conveyance in trust, for any of their general corporate purposes, or in aid of the indigent a id poor, or for the general purposes of education, or for charitable purposes of any description whatsoever, within the limits of the city of Baltimore.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Authorised to sum- That the commissioners of Cecil county be authorised and monses, &c.
