

Passed Feb. 11, 1843. *An act to provide for the appointment of a Flour Inspector and a Wood-Corder in the Town of Westminster, in Carroll County*

Governor authorised to appoint, &c. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, he and he is hereby required annually to appoint in Westminster, in Carroll county, an inspector of flour, whose duty it shall be to inspect all flour offered for sale within the limits of the town of Westminster, in the same manner, and subject to the same rules and regulations in every respect as are now prescribed by law in regard to the inspection of flour in the city of Baltimore, and the said inspector shall be entitled to demand and receive six and a quarter cents for each barrel of flour, which shall be inspected by him, from the seller thereof.

To appoint a Wood-Corder. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the Governor annually to appoint, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, a wood-corder for the town of Westminster, whose duty it shall be to measure and inspect all fire-wood offered for sale in said town of Westminster, in the same manner and subject to the same rules and regulations, in every respect as are now prescribed by law in regard to the inspection of wood in the city of Baltimore, and the wood-corder shall be entitled to demand and receive six and a quarter cents for each cord of wood inspected by him, from the seller thereof.

CHAPTER 105.

Passed Feb. 10, 1843. *An act for the benefit of Jacob Grove, late Sheriff of Carroll County.*

Allowed to collect. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Jacob Grove, late Sheriff of Carroll county, be and he is hereby authorized, to collect all fees and balances due him, or which may be in his hands for collection, at any time before the first day of May eighteen hundred and forty-four, and that for said purposes he shall be entitled to exercise all the powers now vested in Sheriffs by law.

Allowed to serve writs. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said Jacob Grove, be and he is hereby authorized, to levy and execute all
