Preamble.

WHEREAS according to the eighth section of an act entitled, An act to authorize the trustees of the poor of Dorchester county to purchase a farm for the use of the poor, and to sell the present Alms-House of said county, and for other purposes, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and fifty-six, it is provided that the amount to be paid out-pensioners shall not exceed one thousand dollars; and whereas the trustees of the poor for said county have represented to this General Assembly that seven hundred dollars is a sufficient amount to be appropriated by said county for the benefit of

Trustees to SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the discretion as to num. Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act the trustees of the poor for Dorchester county, or a majority of bdr. them, be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to have and keep any number of out-pensioners, that they may think proper; provided the amount paid said out-pensioners, shall not exceed the sum of seven hundred dollars
