

her identity and right to freedom under such deed of manumission or last will and testament. CHAP. 150.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That in all cases where extracts from wills or deeds of manumission shall be made, as by this act, provided, the said extract shall be full and entire, so far as any thing, in such will or deed of manumission contained shall refer to, or affect, or limit the rights of the party, for whose benefit such extract shall be intended. Extract to be full.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the clerk or register, as the case may be, of Howard District, to record all such copies or extracts as aforesaid, under which they shall respectively issue certificates of freedom. Clerk to record.

CHAPTER 149.

*An act to authorise the Commissioners of the tax for Dorchester county, to appoint annually a Constable for the town of Vienna in said county, and to legalize the official acts of Samuel Webb, of said county.* Passed Feb. 21, 1844.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, the commissioners of the tax in and for Dorchester county, be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, to appoint annually a Constable for the town of Vienna, in said county, who shall reside in the said town, and who shall be authorized to exercise all the functions of constable and to the same extent as constables resident of other towns or districts in said county. Commissioners to appoint Constable.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all and singular of the official acts of Samuel Webb, informally appointed constable by the commissioners of the tax for Dorchester county, be, and they are hereby made as legal and to the same extent in every respect, as are the acts of other constables who were appointed at the same term by the said commissioners of the tax in perfect conformity to law. Made legal.
