CHAPTER 224.

An act for the benefit of Thomas Hook.

Passed Feb. 14, 1844.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Thomas Hook, former collector of taxes in Carroll county, be and he is hereby authorised to complete his collection of taxes at any time before the first day of May, eighteen hundred and forty-five, and that he shall be and is hereby authorised to exercise all the rights and powers, conferred by existing laws, on collectors of county taxes, for the purpose of completing his said collections, up to the said first day of May eighteen hundred and forty-five.
