CHAPTER 315.

An additional supplement to an act entitled, an act for founding an Academy at Hagerstown, Washington county, passed at December session eighteen hundred and ten, chapter fifty-five. Passed March 9, 1844.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Election of seven trustees
That an election for seven trustees for the Hagerstown Academy be held on the first Monday of May next, and on the first Monday of every succeeding May thereafter by the stockholders in said institution, in the manner prescribed by the original act, to which this is an additional supplement, at such place in Hagerstown as the president of the board of trustees for the time being shall appoint, of which time and place of election he shall give one month's previous notice in all the newspapers published in Hagerstown; and such seven trustees elected at the time and in the manner above directed, and their successors annually so elected, shall have all the powers, perform all duties and enjoy all the rights and immunities, which were given and granted by the original act above mentioned, and the several supplements thereto.

CHAPTER 316.

An act for the relief of Samuel A. Leckey, of Allegany county. Passed March 9, 1844.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Treasurer of School Fund to pay.
That the treasurer of the school fund of Allegany county, be and he is hereby authorized and directed, to pay to Samuel A. Leckey, of said county, the sum of twenty-four dollars and fifteen cents, being the amount of an order drawn by John Neff, Esq. trustee of a school district in said county, dated August twenty-first, eighteen hundred and forty-one, and also the sum of twenty-six dollars and thirty-seven and one-half cents, being the amount of an order drawn by George S. Evans, a trustee of a school district in said county, dated the thirteenth
