SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall extend to cases now depending and to cases hereafter depending in the Court of Appeals, and shall take effect from and after the day of passing hereof. **In force.**

CHAPTER 42.

An act for the benefit of Thomas Keller, late sheriff of Washington County. **Passed Jan. 25, 1844.**

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Thomas Keller, late sheriff of Washington county, be and he is hereby authorised to collect all fees and balances due him or which may now be in his hands for collection, at any time before the first day of May, eighteen hundred and forty-five, and that for said purposes he shall be entitled to exercise all the powers now vested in sheriffs by law. **Authorised to collect.**

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said Thomas Keller, be and he is hereby authorised to levy and execute all writs of fieri facias or other species of execution, which now may be in his hands, and to make return thereof at any time before the November term of Washington county court, eighteen hundred and forty-four. **May levy and execute.**

CHAPTER 43.

An act for the benefit of the heirs of Henry D. Hatton, late of Prince George's County, deceased. **Passed Jan. 25, 1844.**

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the orphan's court of Prince George's county, be and are hereby authorised and empowered to allow the administratrix of Henry D. Hatton late of said county, to keep together, manage and cultivate the estate of the said Henry D. Hatton, deceased, until the debts are paid or as long as said court may deem proper, if in their judgment they shall believe such management of the estate will be benefi- **Court to allow administratrix to manage, &c**
