*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and directed, to cause to be printed in two papers in the city of Baltimore, and in one German paper, and one paper in each county and Howard District, where a newspaper is printed, such acts passed by the general assembly of the state, as provide for the general revenue of the state, and that the said Treasurer be authorized to pay for said publication out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the State Librarian be authorized and directed to furnish "The Port Deposit Library Association" in Cecil county, with a copy of Dorsey's Laws of Maryland; one copy of Bozman's History of Maryland; and one copy of Convention of Maryland; *provided,* he has a sufficient number of copies on hand for the use of the State Library, and can furnish the same out of the surplus copies.
