- Compensation of assessors and collectors to be fixed, and paid as pointed out in 15th section of original act and 5th and 6th sections of declaratory act, " 9
- Whenever any person assessed under the provisions of the acts to which this is a supplement, shall make oath that his actual income has not exceeded \$300 to be exempt &c. " 10
