

general &c. a list of persons in arrear for taxes, more than a year, and amount due, Attorney General to cause a copy to be stuck up &c. for at least twenty days, prior to court, court may at any time during term, upon motion of Attorney General, cause a rule to be laid upon parties, to show cause within first two days of succeeding term, why judgment should not be entered &c.

Where collectors are not appointed and qualified &c. to enable clerks of levy courts &c. to comply &c., duty of agents appointed by Treasurer to make return to said clerks &c., of monies received by them, amount &c. by each &c., 30 days before term &c.

Fees of clerks of county courts, and deputies of Attorney General &c. not to exceed fifty cents in each case, to each, to be taxed in costs of judgment &c.

Executors &c. to pay taxes due and in arrears, from testators &c. as preferred debts &c. except funeral expenses, on failure bonds to be put in suit &c.

If levy courts &c., fail to impose tax as provided by 52nd section of original act &c. duty of clerks of levy courts &c. to notify Governor within 20 days after failure &c.
