Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of the tax for Anne Arundel county, be and they are hereby authorised and directed to assess and levy on the assessable property of Anne Arundel county, any sum not exceeding four hundred dollars, which sum shall be levied, collected and paid over to the commissioners appointed by this act, as other charges

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That George A. Barber, Richard W. Higgins and Caleb White, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and they or a majority of them, are hereby authorised and required to cause a bridge to be built of good and substantial materials, across the Patuxent river, at or near the place called the Fork of Patuxent, and they are hereby directed, after giving thirty days public notice thereof, at two or more public places, to set up the building of said bridge to the lowest bidder, and the said commissioners or a majority of them, shall require a bond with good and sufficient security, from the person making the lowest bid, faithfully to build and keep in repair the said bridge for ten years.
