Be it enacted by the General Assembly of to receive sur-Maryland, That the mayor and city council of Baltimore, render. be and they are hereby authorised to receive and accept a deed of surrender from the proprietors of the property, to form the bed of a street, to be a continuation of Short street, and to be left open from Jefferson to McElderry streets, and to declare such street to be a public street and highway and subject to the laws and ordinances of the city of Baltimore, in relation to public streets, provided, that all the par- Proviso. ties interested in the bed of the said street, unite in the surrender of the same to the mayor and city council of Baltimore.
