C H A P. CXXXII.

An ACT authorising the commissioners appointed to superintend the Passed 20th of January, 1808. building of the state penitentiary to exchange with the justices of the levy court for Baltimore county the property therein mentioned.

THEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, by the memorial of the said commissi- Preamble. oners, that it would highly promote the conveniencies of the said penitentiary if they were authorised to exchange a part of the lot whereon the said penitentiary is erected, with the justices of the levy court for Baltimore county, for a part of the county gaol lot, so as to reduce the same more nearly to a square; therefore,

II. HEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, by the president and members of the Preamble. New-Market fire company, in the precincts of the city of Baltimore, that they have purchased a fire engine, and other apparatus, for the extinguishment of fire, and have obtained a lot of ground from John Eager Howard for the purpose of creeting thereon a house for the reception of the engine, and to be used for such other purposes as shall tend to promote the interest of the institution; and in order to secure the right and title to the said property, and to give effect to the laws, rules and regulations, which have or may be established by the said company, it has been prayed that an act of incorporation may pass in their favour; therefore,
