C H A P. LIX.

An ACT to lay out and make public an old road in Harford county. Passed 230 Dec. 1808.

HEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, by the petition of sundry inhabitants of Preamble.

Harlord county, that the old road leading from William Ashmore's mill to intersed the road leading from Peach Bottom ferry to Baltimore, on the south side of Slate ridge, where the old road crosses said road, has been found to be convenient and useful to the public, and praying that the same may be made a public road, and that commissioners be appointed to survey and lay out said road; and the same being reasonable, therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Joseph Scarborough, Sedgwick Persons ap-James and Josiah Slade, be and they, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised and empowered to pointed, &c. lay out, survey, mark and bound, the old road, beginning at William Ashmore's mill, and running thence so as to intersect the road leading from Peach Bottom to Baltimore, on the south side of Slate ridge, where the old road now crosses said road, and to straighten the same, if, in their judgment, they should deem it necessary; provided, that the said old road shall not be laid out or straightened through the lands of any person or persons without his, her or their consent, in writing, first had and obtained, and a plot of said road, when surveyed and laid out, together with a certificate of the courses of the same, shall be returned by the commissioners aforesaid to the clerk of said county, to be by him recorded.
