## CHAPTER 115.

Passed Mar. 5, 1839. *An act to authorize Thomas M. D. Baden, Collector of Taxes of Prince George's County, further time to complete his collections*

Authority to collect

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Thomas M. D. Baden, collector of taxes for Prince George's county, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to collect taxes or any balance of taxes now remaining due and uncollected by him, in the county aforesaid, in the same manner, and with the same power and privileges as are allowed by the existing laws of this State in said cases made and provided.*

Accounts to be rendered under oath

**Sec. 2.** *And be it enacted, That Thomas M. D. Baden, shall, in every instance, before he may proceed to the aforesaid collection, make affidavit before some justice of the peace of said county, that the same remains unpaid, and that he hath not received any security or satisfaction for the same, or any part thereof, more than what credits may be allowed thereon.*

Time specified

**Sec. 3.** *And be it enacted, That this act shall not continue in force longer than the first day of July eighteen hundred and forty.*
