CHAPTER 132.

Passed Feb. 28, 1839. *An act allowing Elijah Taylor, former Collector of the first collection district of Baltimore County, further time to complete his collections.*

Act of 1833, chap. 136, extended

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act, entitled, an act to authorize Elijah Taylor, former collector of taxes in the first collection district in Baltimore county, to complete his collections, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, chapter one hundred and thirty-six, be, and the same is hereby continued in full force and effect, until the first day of January, eighteen hundred and forty-one, anything in the act aforesaid, or in any other act of Assembly to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER 133.

Passed Mar. 5, 1839. *An act to divorce Joseph Browne, of Kent County, from his wife Mary Browne.*

Divorce

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Joseph Browne, of Kent county, be, and he is hereby divorced from his wife Mary Browne, a *vinculo matrimonii*.
