CHAPTER 132.

Passed Feb. 28, In act allowing Elijah Taylor, former Collector of the first collection district of Baltimore County, further time to complete his collections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,
That an act, entitled, an act to authorize Elijah Taylor, former collector of taxes in the first collection
district in Baltimore county, to complete his collections, passed at December session, eighteen hundred
and thirty-five, chapter one hundred and thirty-six,
be, and the same is hereby continued in full force and
effect, until the first day of January, eighteen hundred
and forty-one, anything in the act aforesaid, or in any
other act of Assembly to the contrary notwithstanding.
