

CHAPTER 138.

CHAP. 129.

A supplement to the Charter of Washington Medical College of Baltimore. Passed Mar. 6, 1839.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Washington Medical College of Baltimore, be, and the same is hereby authorized to constitute, appoint and annex, to itself, the other three Colleges or Faculties, viz: the Faculty of Law, the Faculty of Divinity, the Faculty of the Arts and Sciences; and such Academies, or preparatory School, or Schools, as may be deemed essential to the support and maintenance of said colleges or faculties. May add Faculty of Law, Divinity, and Arts and Sciences

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Washington Medical College, and the Faculties, Academies and preparatory Schools, hereby authorized to be annexed, shall be known and called the Washington University of Baltimore. Name and style

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the officers and their successors, who are now vested with the power to make by-laws, for the regulation and government of the Washington Medical College, be, and are hereby authorized and empowered, to make and pass all such by-laws, as may be necessary for the good government and regulation of the Washington University of Baltimore. May make by laws

CHAPTER 139.

An act for the benefit of the German Reformed Congregation of Christ's Church, in Cavetown, Washington County, Maryland. Passed Mar. 6, 1839.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Daniel Huyett, Jacob Krouse and Peter Colliflower be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to sell a certain house and lot, the property of the German Reformed Congregation of Christ's Church, situate in Cavetown, Washington county, Maryland, as soon as convenient, and to convey the same to the purchaser, or purchasers, by a good deed in fee simple.
