CHAPTER 140.

Passed Mar. 6, 1839. *An act supplementary to an act, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore Friendly Society, passed at December session eighteen hundred and nineteen.*

Preamble

WHEREAS, the tenth section of an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore Friendly Society, passed December session eighteen hundred and nineteen, provides as follows: "Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That this act shall be and remain in force until the first day of January eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly of Maryland which shall happen thereafter; and as the aforesaid act will expire at the end of the present session of the Legislature, and the members of said society are still desirous of its continuance;—Therefore,

Original act continued till 1875

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That an act, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore Friendly Society, passed at December session eighteen hundred and nineteen, shall be and remain in force until the first day of January, eighteen hundred and seventy five, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly of Maryland, which shall happen thereafter.

CHAPTER 141.

Passed Mar. 8, 1839. *A further supplement to the act of Eighteen hundred and thirty. chapter one hundred and sixty, entitled, an act to extend the powers of the commissioners of the School Fund in Queen Anne's County, and to encourage the establishment of Free Schools in said County.*
