CHAPTER 179.

Passed Mar. 12, 1839. *A supplement to an act, entitled, an act for the promotion of Internal Improvements, passed at the adjourned May session of Eighteen hundred and thirty-six, chapter three hundred and ninety-five.*

Power of Commissioners revoked

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all power and authority, vested and remaining in the commissioners appointed under the original act, to which this is a supplement, be and the same are hereby revoked, and annulled, and the duties to be performed under said act, by said commissioners, are hereby devolved upon the Treasurer of the Western Shore.

CHAPTER 180.

Passed Mar. 13, 1839. *An act to divorce Edward Colegate, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife, Ann Eliza Colegate.*

Divorce

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Edward Colegate of the city of Baltimore, be, and he is hereby divorced from his wife Ann Eliza Colegate, a vinculo matrimonii.

CHAPTER 181.

Passed Mar. 12, 1839. *An act to Divorce Emilie W. Noble, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband Nathaniel G. Noble.*

Divorce

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Emilie W. Noble, of the city of Baltimore, be, and she is hereby divorced from her husband Nathaniel G. Noble, a vinculo matrimonii.
