CHAPTER 192.

Passed Mar. 18; An act to encourage the growth of the Mulberry and the raising of Silk at the Alms and Work House of Montgomery County.

WHEREAS, it appears to this Legislature, that the growing of the Mulberry and the production of Silk at the Alms and Work House of Montgomery county. may lessen the annual expense of said house to said county, and furnish useful and easy labour to a portion of its inmates who may not otherwise have employment, or be so usefully employed.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Levy di reted Maryland, That the commissioners for Montgomery county, shall levy on the assessable property of said county, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding however in all, the sum of one hundred and eighty dollars, as may from time to ime, be required by the
