CHAP. 195 county to be applied to such purposes as are now, or may hereafter be provided for by law.

Sec. S. And be it enacted. That John Michaels. Jacob Shimberger and Simon Markey, are by virtue of this act appointed commissioners, to superintend the building of said bridge, and they shall require the person or persons, who shall contract with them for the build ing of said bridge to give boud with full and ample security, for the faithful performance of the said contract, and the compensation allowed to the bridge commissioners, for superintending and causing to have erected, said bridge, shall be discretionary with the commissioners of Baltimore county.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted. That all acts, or parts of acts heretofore passed upon this subject inconsistent or repugnant with the provisions of this act, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 195.

Passed Mar. 18, An act to incorporate the Friendship Society of Baltimare. 1839

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Richard C. Mason, Evan Hamilton, S. F. Streeter, William Bayley, Stephen Broadbent. M. Dorsey, and Levi Taylor, the present officers, directors and members of the Friendship Society, of the City of Baltimore, and their successors, be, and they are hereby declared to be a community corporation and body politic, forever, by the name, style and title of the Friendship Society of Baltimore, and by that name, they and their successors, shall and may, at all times hereafter, be capable in law, to have, receive and retain to them and their successors, property, real and personal, also devises and bequests of any person or persons bodies, corporate and politic, capable of making the same, and the same at their pleasure to trans-

fer and dispose of in such manner, as they may think proper, Provided always, that the said corporation or body politic, shall not at any time, hold or possess, property, real, personal or mixed, exceeding in annual

value, five thousand dollars.
